Hardware


Consider the quality and finish of the tracks, rollers, and handles.

Measuring for Sliding Doors





Measure the opening width at the top, middle, and bottom to ensure a perfect fit.

Height

Measure the opening height at the left, center, and right to account for any uneven surfaces.

Clearance

Ensure there is enough clearance for the door to slide and operate smoothly.

Installation Considerations

Wall Preparation

Ensure the wall opening is level, plumb, and properly prepared for the door frame.

Proper Framing


Use the appropriate framing materials and techniques to ensure structural integrity.

Precise Alignment

Carefully align the door panels and hardware for smooth, effortless operation.







Maintenance and Care



Regular Cleaning

Wipe down the door surfaces and hardware to maintain their appearance and function.



Lubrication

Apply a silicone-based lubricant to the rollers and tracks to ensure smooth operation.



Periodic Inspection

Check for any loose hardware, worn components, or signs of wear and tear.
