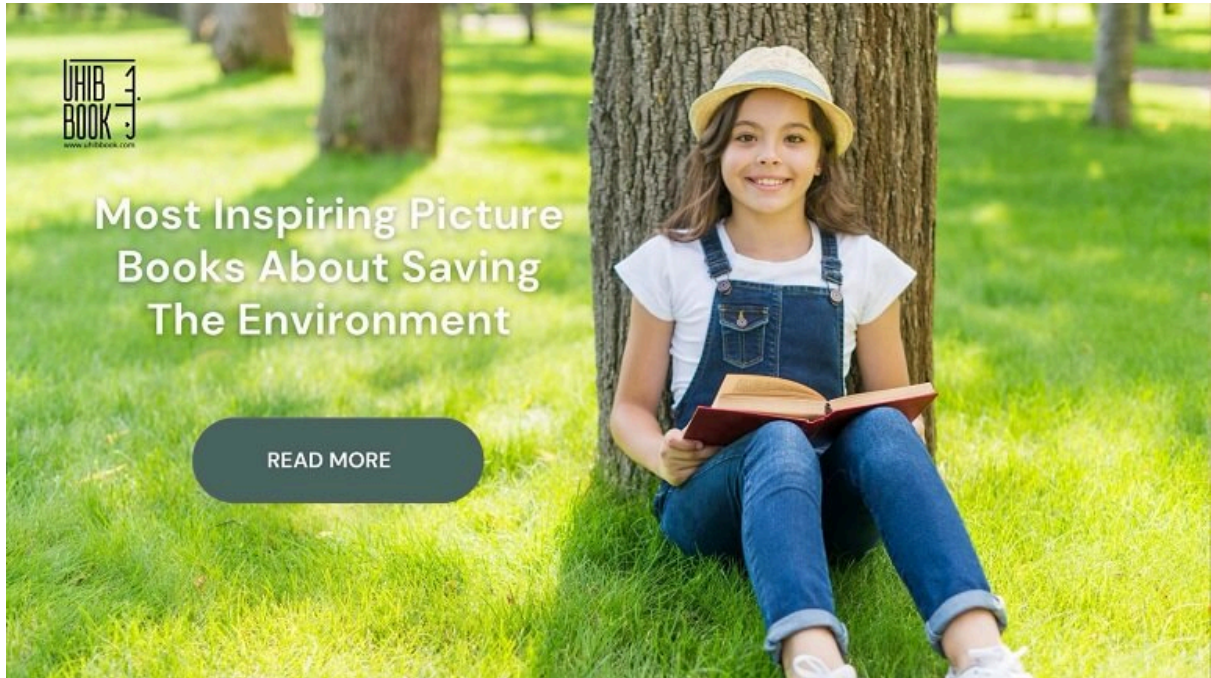


# Most Inspiring Picture Books About People Saving The Environment

### #1 - Dr. Seuss's "The Lorax":

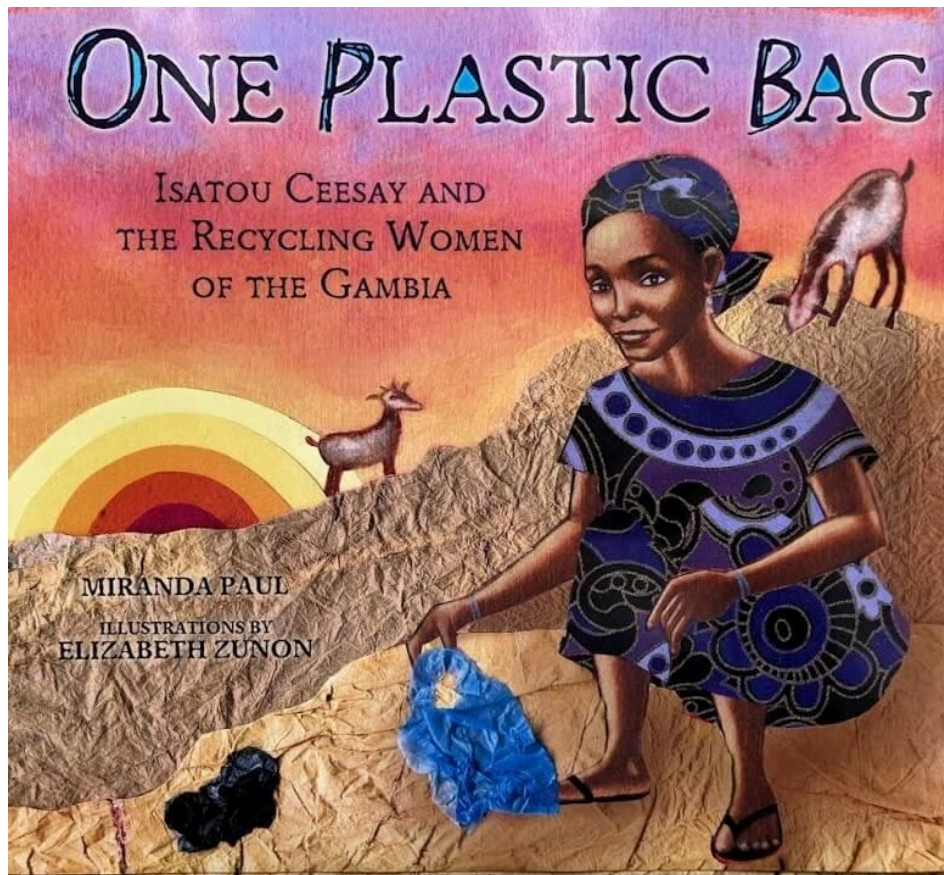
